



**Supplementary Fig. S2.** Microscopic details of cardiac sarcoidosis in the first transplant heart. (A) High magnification of the myocardium at the right ventricular trabeculae reveals vague nodules of granuloma-like lesions and fatty transformation of the myocardium. (B) Immunohistochemical staining for CD68 in the same area shows a small nodular collection of eleven histiocytes. (C) Magnification the right ventricular free wall at the apex reveals absence of myocardium in the free wall but a thin layer of fibrotic wall is covered by epicardial fatty tissue. The myocardium stained violet is seen only in the trabeculae.
